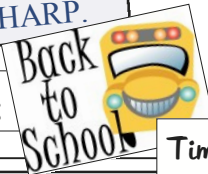

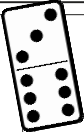

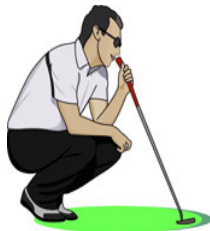


The wee man fae Falkirk George Millar took a wee spill at home which has been keeping him from the golf course and the club.

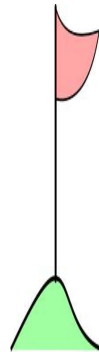
